



GENERAL RULES

- **Respect for peace and quiet and timetables**

Please respect the peace and quiet of all guests in the Oasis Pool area.

The pool area is open daily (from 10:00 am to 6:00 pm), except for private events or early closures, which will be communicated in advance. Please respect the staff's instructions.

Loitering in the pool area after closing time (6:00 pm) is not permitted.

- **Access**

Pass through the showers and foot basins before entering the pool.

Wear a swim cap in the water or tie your hair. Use non-slip slippers.

- **Cleanliness and decorum**

Do not leave clothing or shoes in the changing rooms.

Wear flip-flops or slippers in the bathrooms and all areas surrounding the pool, and do not walk barefoot in the bathrooms.

Use a towel on the loungers and, upon exiting, place the used towel in the designated bin.

Wear a T-shirt or beach cover-up in the bar area.

- **Pool Behavior**

Smoking is prohibited in the pool area.

Running on the poolside, diving into the water, pushing people, bringing prohibited objects (mats, inflatables, or toys that disturb the peace), and playing with balls or paddles in the water are prohibited. Management reserves the right to remove guests from the pool in the event of disruptive or dangerous behavior.

- **Children**

Children under certain ages (e.g., 3 years old) may be required to wear swimwear or diapers.

An accompanying adult is required for younger children. Children must be under the active supervision of an adult at all times. Management declines all responsibility for unsupervised minors.

- **Food and Drink**

Consuming food and drinks in the pool is prohibited. Bringing food and drinks from outside is prohibited.

- **Personal Items**

It's advisable to bring a bag or backpack to store clothing and shoes.

Please don't leave valuables unattended. Management declines all responsibility for theft or loss within the pool area.

- **Electronic Devices**

Please silence your cell phone, speak softly, or leave the area during phone calls to avoid disturbing the peace and quiet.

- **Pets**

Animals are not allowed in the pool area, even if kept on a leash.

- **Read the rules**

Before going to the pool, it's advisable to read the rules carefully to understand all the rules to follow.

- **Respect the rules**

Follow the instructions of staff and lifeguards to ensure safety and the proper conduct of activities.

- **Report any problems**

In case of need or emergency, it's important to contact the pool staff.
